## **Disciples Were Deeply Troubled**

#### John 16:1-2

I have told you these things so that you won't abandon your faith. For you will be expelled from the synagogues, and the time is coming when those who kill you will think they are doing a holy service for God. Jesus gave them 3 sets of instructions for facing an uncertain future:

a. Trust and remain in Me – Faith
b. Remain in my love – Love
c. Take heart, be courageous – Hope

## John 14:1 Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me.

1. You have trusted in God

#### Deuteronomy 31:6

So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the LORD your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you.

#### 2. You can also trust in Me

John 14:6 This is who I Am: Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.

#### John 14:9-11

My Father and I share a unique relationship:

- <sup>9</sup> Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father!
- <sup>10</sup> Don't you believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me?
- <sup>11</sup> Just believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me.

#### 3. You must remain in Me

#### John 15:4-5

<sup>4</sup> Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me.<sup>5</sup> "Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.


## The Blessings in Trusting Jesus

#### John 14:12-14

<sup>12</sup> "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. <sup>13</sup> You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. <sup>14</sup> Yes, ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!

## 1. Remain in My Love

#### Love

#### John 15:9-11

<sup>9</sup> "I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love.<sup>10</sup> When you obey my commandments, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father's commandments and remain in his love. <sup>11</sup> I have told you these things so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow!"

<sup>1</sup> Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the old heaven and the old earth had disappeared. And the sea was also gone. <sup>2</sup> And I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven like a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

#### Revelation 21:1-4

<sup>3</sup> I heard a loud shout from the throne, saying, "Look, God's home is now among his people! He will live with them, and they will be his people. God himself will be with them.<sup>4</sup> - will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever."

## The Blessings in holding on to our Hope:

- Supernatural peace (John 16:33)
- Great joy in looking forward to that blissful day (Romans 5:1-2)

How do we appropriate Faith, Love and Hope during our time of trial?



## **Guided Contemplation**

- a. What is one major challenge that you are presently facing?
- b. Faith: Can you trust Jesus to see you through this trial? How can you involve Him in this situation?
- c. Love: Do you believe that God is still good, kind and loving to you? Even when you are hurting?

## **Guided** Contemplation

- d. Hope: Jesus has overcome the world and you have a secure place in heaven. How can this hope encourage you in your present situation? (Romans 8:18)
- e. Hope: What has the Lord promised you regarding this present trial? Will you keep praying for God's promise (rhema) to be fulfilled? (John 15:7)

John 15:7 But if you remain in me and my words (rhema) remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted!
